COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

PRENEED FUNERAL ARRANGEMENTS

2 CEUs

Participants must attend both segments of the program to receive CEUs.

Preneed A-1 • New Jersey Preneed—The Basics

This seminar will review the accepted methods of tying prearrangements to prepaid agreements: trusts, newly issued insurance policies and the assignment of existing insurance policies. Mortuary and practitioner requirements, components of agreements and recordkeeping mandates will be covered. A discussion of Mortuary Board notifications, required disclosures and prohibited acts will wrap up the session.

Preneed B-2 • Assignment of Insurance Proceeds to Fund Prepaid Funeral Arrangements

This seminar will explain the complex and time-consuming process involved in the assignment of existing life insurance proceeds to fund prepaid funeral arrangements. Participants will learn how to navigate the assignment process with both revocable and irrevocable prearrangements, ensuring that the funeral firm is paid and the intended funeral recipient's benefits are not jeopardized.

NEW JERSEY LAW AND RULES

2 CEUs

Participants must attend both segments of the program to receive CEUs.

Law A-2 • Who Has the Right to Control Disposition?

This seminar outlines the high level of liability imposed on every mortuary registration when licensed funeral directors determine the appropriate individual(s) to make decisions regarding funeral arrangements and disposition. Participants will engage in an extensive analysis of the Right to Control Law (N.J.S.A. 45:27-22) and its implications for funeral service.

Law B-1 • Work First New Jersey/Indigent Funerals

This seminar will outline the provisions of the New Jersey laws concerning the burial of economically disadvantaged individuals. Participants will learn who has the right to control funeral arrangements and disposition; what reimbursement rates are available; how family supplementation applies; and what irregularities can occur.

2017 MANDATORY OSHA FUNERAL HOME TRAINING

2 CEUs

Full- and part-time as well as per diem funeral home employees, compliance officers and anyone who maintains a written OSHA compliance plan or enters a prep room, will benefit from this educational opportunity. Participants must attend both segments of the program to receive CEUs.

OSHA A-3 • OSHA Paperwork Obligations

This seminar will cover Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) regulations as they relate to funeral service personnel with oversight responsibility. The necessity of maintaining a written communication plan with the associated paperwork will be discussed. OSHA's Bloodborne Pathogens and Formaldehyde Standards will be reviewed.

OSHA A-5 • Preventing Back Injuries in Funeral Service—OSHA Ergonomics

This seminar will review the effective application of safe work practices that funeral home personnel can implement to prevent back and spinal injuries. Participants will discuss safe work practices regarding the removal and transfer of human remains; embalming, dressing and casketing; handling and lifting caskets; transporting human remains through a building; and receiving and stocking supplies.

FUNERAL DIRECTING ETHICS

1 CEU

Ethics A-1 • Ethical Dilemmas in Funeral Service

This seminar addresses the complexities of ethical decision-making in the funeral profession absent the typical complex, philosophical or intellectual debate of other ethics seminars. Through a practical discussion of "real-life" industry examples, participants will hear ways that funeral directors can establish ethical work practices that may reduce the possibility of questionable funeral home practices or wrongdoing.
