Course Descriptions

NEW JERSEY PRENEED FUNERAL ARRANGEMENTS (2 CEUs)

Participants must attend both segments of in-person event to receive CEUs.

NJ Preneed Basics with Althea D. Ford

This course will review the basic statutory and regulatory requirements for executing compliant preneed funeral agreements in New Jersey.

Assignment of Insurance Proceeds to Fund Prepaid Funeral Arrangements with Althea D. Ford

Attendees will learn how to navigate the insurance assignment process with both revocable and irrevocable prearrangements ensuring that the funeral home is paid, and the intended funeral recipient's benefits are not jeopardized.

FUNERAL DIRECTING ETHICS (1 CEU)

Ethical Dilemmas in Funeral Service with George R. Kelder Jr., CFSP

This course reviews ways that funeral directors can establish ethical work practices that may reduce the possibility of questionable funeral home practices or wrongdoing.

Mortuary Operations with Althea D. Ford
